Explain how your company defines and views its relationship with biosecurity and what commitments have been made at Board and Leadership level around biosecurity risk management.

- 2. Does your company have any biosecurity awareness training or programme for staff?

  Outline any form of induction on biosecurity, training programmes and awareness activites undertaken by your company, and outline the progress achieved with these. If you do not have any such programmes, outline any future intentions to develop such, or whether your company would be willing to use Auckland Airport provided materials.
- 3. What are the main biosecurity challenges and opportunities relating to the activities of your company?

Explain any biosecurity challenges and opportunities you believe are the most material to your business and provide details on what you are doing (or plan to do) to effectively manage these issues. (Answer n/a if your company does not have any identified biosecurity challenges, risks or opportunities)

 How will your company manage any biosecurity obligations or risks in relation to any activities which you will physically undertake at Auckland Airport.

Auckland Airport is a Place of First Arrival under the Biosecurity Act, and Port of Entry under the WHO International Health Regulations 2005, which means it is a key biosecurity entry point to New Zealand, and has obligations to manage and so far as practicable, eliminate, biosecurity risks. Explain what processes and/or policies you have to ensure that any biosecurity risks are identified and managed in relation to the activities you will be undertaking at Auckland Airport, or any goods, aircraft or people you will be moving through Auckland Airport facilities. (Answer n/a if you believe your company will not be creating any biosecurity risks or be impacted by Auckland Airport's status as a key international gateway to New Zealand).
