

## NZ WINEGROWERS GRAFTED GRAPEVINE STANDARDS – BIOSECURITY MANAGEMENT SECTION

<i>Requirement</i>  6.2  <i>Signage</i>	<p>Nurseries will use signage to inform visitors that access control and biosecurity are important, and that they have a responsibility to ensure they do not bring unwanted pests or pathogens on to nursery sites.</p> <p>Nurseries shall provide evidence of signage that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Highlights the importance of biosecurity to the nursery environment</li><li>b) Indicates that entry is restricted to permitted persons only</li><li>c) Shows visitors where to park</li><li>d) Directs visitors to the office or provides contact details for a visitor to log their presence</li></ul>
<i>Requirement</i>  6.3  <i>Visitors</i>	<p>People moving between nurseries and other horticultural enterprises can unknowingly spread pests and diseases. Nurseries should have mitigation measures in place to minimize this threat. Vehicles can also harbour and transfer pests, particularly when contaminated with plant material or growing media.</p> <p>Nurseries shall be able to provide evidence of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) How visitors are made aware of biosecurity and nursery hygiene requirements</li><li>b) How the biosecurity risks presented by visitors and their vehicles are mitigated</li><li>c) Where the visitor register is located and how it is maintained.</li></ul>
